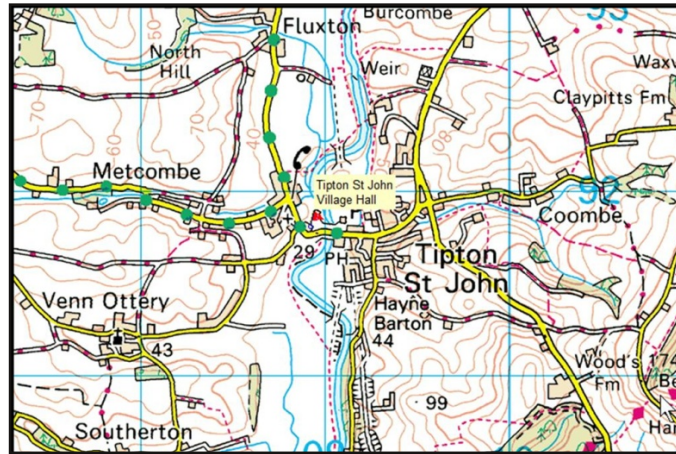
Serving our Community

Whichever way you come, we are adjacent to the School and opposite the Church. We are at the convergence of the roads from Ottery St Mary, Metcombe and Venn Ottery.

From Ottery St Mary, take the B 3174 and turn into Strawberry Lane, follow the road through Fluxton to Tipton St John.

From Sidmouth Road at the Bowd take the Ottery road, after 1.5 miles turn left into Tipton St John, and head through the village passing The Golden Lion, Village Shop and Garage, continue over the river and the village hall is on the right and its car park is on the left.

Location and Facilities

Tipton St John has a strong active community spirit and the Community Hall plays an important part in hosting activities held by the various groups and events.

The hall is situated at the heart of the village close to the school, shop, public house, playing fields and local garage. The hall was awarded Hallmark** status in September 2010.

The facilities have benefited from a high quality upgrade, encompassing appropriate lighting and sound systems, and provide a pleasant atmosphere in the main hall for theatre productions, a variety of entertainment and events.

The well equipped professional kitchen has direct access to the main hall and enables easy service of hot and cold catering, which is important for anyone requiring a private hire venue. The toilet and cloakroom facilities are also to a high standard.



Small venue hire is available to the rear of the premises, which opens onto a small grassed area. Small groups or committees would find the room able to accommodate their activities, and on application computer, printer and scanner equipment could be made available (including internet connection).

The ample car park is situated opposite the community hall entrance.

The Community Hall Trustees are keen to make the hall available to anyone or organisation interested in hiring the venues and further information is available via the Booking Clerk.
